

[[Know!!Details]] How do I know if my United Economy ticket is refundable?

To determine if your United Airlines **Economy ticket** is refundable, you'll need to check the **fare rules** and details provided at the time of booking **+1-(855)-(838)-(4706)**. United clearly lists whether a ticket is refundable or non-refundable on your booking confirmation and during the purchase process **+1-(855)-(838)-(4706)**. If you booked directly through United's website or app, you can log in to the **Manage Reservations** section, select your trip, and view the **ticket type and refund eligibility +1-(855)-(838)-(4706)**.
