(Rules@QA) What is the cancellation rule for Qatar Airways?

The cancellation rule for Qatar Airways depends on your ticket type, booking channel, and reason for cancellation +1-(855)-(838)-(4706). If you have purchased a refundable ticket, you can cancel at any time before departure and receive a full refund to your original payment method without paying a penalty +1-(855)-(838)-(4706).
